Students who have earned at least 15 AR points will receive 15 addition bonus points towards their reading grade. Students may test at any time, but we will have an AR test day every 2 weeks.

We will take the STAR reading and math tests on October 12th and 13th. These tests allow the teachers to monitor the students' progress as well as set new goals.

Parent / Teacher conferences are coming up on October 13th and 14th. You can come visit with the teachers on Tuesday, October 13th, from 3:30 to 5:00 pm. You can also visit with the

teachers on Wednesday, October 14th, from 8:00 to 10:00 am. Both 5th grade teachers will be in the hallway ready to hand out report cards and talk about your student's progress. We appreciate any feedback you may have, and welcome any questions as well. We are looking forward to seeing you all!

Book It has begun and takes place October through March. You should have received the Book It tracking calendar for October in the Thursday folder. The goal is to read for 20 minutes at least 4 days a week. Your student will earn a pizza certificate from Pizza Hut if he or she meets the goal. Book It calendars are due October 30th.
